Trained Coach: COMMUNITY SPORT COACH PROGRAM-"Introduction to Orienteering"

Who should do it: for anyone looking to coach and get involved with kids programs /club's junior programs. Volunteers /parents/ young community coaches/ sport enthusiasts.

Course: 9-10 hours long / will receive NCCP number but there is no formal evaluation of Community Coaches after the workshop and remains "Trained".

<u>Certified Coach: COMPETITION - INTRODUCTION - "Coach training and certification "</u>

For coaches and volunteers with previous experience, who would like to grow their knowledge about sport specific training and become a certified coach.

The curriculum is aligned with the needs of the young athletes in the Train to Train Stages of Orienteering's <u>LTAD</u>. The program can easily be adapted to older age groups as a starting stage for the Active for Life participants.

- The evaluation process involves an observed practice session that has been planned and set-up by the coach.
- A certified Coach Evaluator, will acknowledge that all the requirements have been met.
