Although we scheduled our lessons for 1 per month, we appreciate the flexibility in how the program is structured so that it can be easily adapted for four consecutive days, weekly for a month, monthly for a term, even seasonally or tailored however necessary. How convenient that the lessons can also be implemented with various group sizes and ages provided that there are sufficient volunteers to assist in operating and supervising one of the three groups!

Orange Marks the Spot, the pilot of 4 orienteering lessons developed by Orienteering Alberta partnering with Be Fit for Life Network to promote physical literacy can be easily adapted and integrated into many areas of the educational curriculum beyond Social Studies, Physical Education and Outdoor Education. The students further develop their visual-spatial orientation and apply their navigational skills, develop a greater respect for nature and landmarks.
