

# Membership




- Preliminary numbers
- Approx. 750 FWOC members in 2019
- SOGO:
  - ~500 Youth members
  - ~75 Adult members
  - Estimates (from combined spring & fall seasons)

#### Events



- Nearly continuous weekly events between Mar 24 and Nov 10
  - Spring Campus Series (Mar Apr)
  - Wednesday Nights (Apr Aug)
  - Fall Sprint/Training (Sep Nov)
- Alberta Orienteering Champs (June 29-30)









## Junior Development

  - 2019 was better!
